The petitioner seeks regular bail in case FIR No.143 dated 31.7.2018, registered at Police Station Baghapurana, District Moga, under Section 379-B IPC.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the investigation is complete and challan has been presented in Court, but the examination of PWs has not yet started. The trial is not likely to be concluded at an early date. There is no criminal case pending against the petitioner. Thus, he may be granted regular bail.

Learned State counsel does not dispute the aforementioned factual submissions made on behalf of the petitioner.

Keeping in view the fact that the trial is not likely to be concluded at an early date and that the petitioner does not have any other criminal case pending against him, I deem it appropriate to allow this petition. Accordingly, the petition is allowed and

petitioner-Jagpal Singh @ Pali, is ordered to be released on bail on his
furnishing bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court
concerned.
