Vide this common order CRM-M Nos.4736 and 6185 of 2018 are being decided as common controversy is involved in both the petitions.

Prayer made in both the petitions is for transfer of investigation in case bearing FIR No.181 dated 17.12.2016

registered under Sections 341/506/34 IPC at Police Station Adampur, District Jalandhar Rural and FIR No.139 dated 03.10.2016 registered under Sections 323/325/341/295/379/148/149 IPC at Police Station Adampur, District Jalandhar to an officer above the rank of Superintendent of Police.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that the parties have amicably settled their grievances by entering into composite compromise in FIR No.139 dated 03.10.2016 under Sections 323/325/341/295/379/148/149 IPC, P.S. Adampur, District Jalandhar, FIR No.44 dated 18.02.2010 under Sections 419, 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC, P.S. Division No.4, Jalandhar and in FIR No.181 dated 17.12.2016, under Sections 341/506/34 IPC, Police Station Adampur, District Jalandhar Rural. Criminal misc. petitions for quashing of the said FIRs have already been filed in the High Court in which notice of motion has already been issued for 22.03.2018 and parties have deposed before the concerned Court in the context of compromise.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Kewal Singh submitted that the challan has already been presented and the petitions have become infructuous.

In view of above development, I deem it appropriate to dispose of the petitions as having become infructuous.

Ordered accordingly.

Since the parties have resolved their controversy, Investigating Officers of the FIRs mentioned in the preceding part of the order are directed not to adopt any coercive method till 22.03.2018.
