Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.PC is for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 to conduct fair and impartial investigation in FIR No.34 dated 12.07.2018 under Section 21 of the NDPS Act, 1985 registered at Police Station Sehna, District Barnala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has argued that the aforesaid FIR has been registered against the petitioner. He further states that at this stage, the petitioner would be satisfied in case respondent No.2-Superintendent of Police, Barnala is directed to consider the representation dated 15.08.2018 (Annexure P-4) made by the petitioner.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3 only.

On asking of this Court, Mr. Rana Harjasdeep Singh, Deputy Advocate General, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of these respondents.

Let requisite number of copies of paper book be given to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

Without commenting anything upon the merits of the case, but considering the limited prayer made by the petitioner for fair investigation in the aforesaid FIR, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to look into the contents of representation dated 15.08.2018 (Annexure P-4) and to act in accordance with law.
