This is a petition that has been filed for issuance of appropriate directions to the official respondents for completing investigation and submitting final report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. in FIR No.83 dated 03.04.2015 under Section 406, 498-A, 506, 323, 324 IPC with additions of Sections 468 and 471 IPC registered at Police Station, Jandiala Guru, District Amritsar (Rural).

Notice of motion was issued in the said matter and reply by way of affidavit of Gurpartap Singh Sahota, PPS, DSP, Sub Division Jandiala, Distt. Amritsar (Rural) has been filed in Court today and same is taken on record. It is submitted that the matter was investigated against Ramandeep Singh, husband and Kuldeep Kaur, mother-in-law. Role of other relatives namely Ramandeep Singh, dewar, Gursharan Singh, maternal uncle and Beant Kaur alias Gursharan Kaur, maternal aunt was examined and they have been declared innocent.

The reply also reveals that investigation has been completed in the said matter and the challan has been prepared against Ramandeep Singh, husband and respondent No.5- Kuldeep Kaur on 20th of March

2018 and the same is to be presented in Court.

I have heard learned counsel for the respondent-State and in view of the fact that the challan is ready, let the same be presented in Court within a period of two weeks.

In view of the above, no further orders are called for.

The petition stands disposed off accordingly.
