The grievance of the petitioner is that he was falsely implicated in an FIR under the NDPS Act, 1985. Although, representations dated 16.8.2018 (Annexure P5 and P6) have been submitted, but the police is not taking any action under Section 58 of the aforementioned Act.

Mr. R.S. Bains, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 4. Let five copies of the petition be supplied to him during the course of the day.

In view of the nature of the order being passed, there is no necessity to call upon respondent Nos.5 to 8, at this stage.

The petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.3 to objectively consider the representation 16.8.2018 (Annexure P6) and to take appropriate action, in accordance with law, in case it is felt necessary, within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
