Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of direction to respondent No.2 to investigate the matter and take legal action against respondent No.4-Raj Kumar.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that petitioner No.2-Mohan Singh, who retired from Indian Army in the year 2002, has purchased land by way of two different sale deeds i.e. Annexures P-3 and P-4 dated 04.09.2002 and 05.09.2002 respectively, from respondent No.4 for a total sale consideration of Rs.17,25,000/-. However, now he has come to know that the said land was not owned by respondent No.4, rather was in the ownership of Gram Panchayat, Chaloya, Tehsil and District Pathankot. Petitioners have submitted a complaint/representation dated 16.03.2018 (Annexure P/5) to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Pathankot to take legal action against respondent No.4.

Notice of motion only to respondents No.1 to 3 at this stage.

At the asking of the Court, Mr.Rana Harjasdeep Singh, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of these respondents.

Let requisite number of copies of paper book be given to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

Without observing anything on the merits of the case, lest it may prejudice to respondent No.4, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Pathankot to look into representation dated 16.03.2018 (Annexure P/5) and to act in accordance with law.
