The learned counsel submits that despite the petitioners having made representations (Annexures P-3 and P-4) to various authorities of the police, no action has been taken thereupon. Although it is duly established that Sushma Devi wife of Vinod Kumar Kaushal in connivance with Amit Bhatti, AFSO, Civil Supplies and Consumer Affairs, Talwara, Munish Bassi, Inspector, Food and Supplies, Hazipur and Madan Lal, Secretary, Block Development and Panchayat Officer, Block Talwara, had forged the resolution of the Panchayat so as to derive undue benefits of allotment of depot, which was infact to be allotted to another person i.e. Sushma Devi wife of Partap Singh, who had applied for the same, whereas infact Sushma Devi wife of Vinod Kumar Kaushal had never applied for the same and was herself a Panch of the village.

Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioners, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3-Senior Superintendent of Police, District Hoshiarpur to look into the matter and to

dispose of the representation Annexure P-4 expeditiously preferably within a period of six months from today in accordance with law. While deciding the same respondent No.3-Senior Superintendent of Police, District Hoshiarpur shall also look into the allegations as levelled in representations (Annexures P-2 and P-3). In case the allegations contained therein are found to be well founded then necessary steps be taken thereupon as warranted under law. A copy of this order alongwith representations (Annexure P-2, P-3 and P-4) be sent to respondent No.3-Senior Superintendent of Police, District Hoshiarpur so as to enable him to do the needful expeditiously.
