This order shall dispose of the present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C praying for the grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.200 dated 29.9.2017 under sections 420, 465, 468, 471 I.P.C, registered at Police Station, Kotwali, Patiala, District Patiala.

Briefly noticed, FIR came to be registered on the allegations that the petitioner had secured employment in the Punjab State Transmission Corporation Ltd. on the strength of forged educational certificates.

The present petition came up for preliminary hearing on 7.12.2017 and while issuing notice of motion, this Court granted ad interim protection to the petitioner subject to his joining investigation.

Learned State counsel upon instructions from SI Sukhdev Singh would apprise the Court that the petitioner has since joined investigation.

That apart, services of the petitioner already stand terminated and he has even returned the salary that had been paid to him for the period that he remained in service.

In the considered view of this Court, custodial interrogation of the petitioner, as such, would not be warranted. Accordingly, the present petition is allowed. The order dated 7.12.2017, passed by this Court, is made absolute.

Petition disposed of.
