This order shall dispose of the present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C praying for the grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.85 dated 27.9.2017 under sections 364, 323, 341, 506, 148, 149 I.P.C and section 25 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station, Sadar Sunam, District Sangrur.

Briefly noticed, allegation against the present petitioner is of having delivered a *dang* blow on the legs and back of the complainant namely Jagtar Singh @ Gazi.

It has gone uncontroverted that the injury attributed to the present petitioner has been opined to be simple in nature.

Furthermore, learned State counsel has informed that petitioner in pursuance to the order dated 7.12.2017 has since joined investigation.

In the considered view of this Court, custodial interrogation of the petitioner, as such, would not be warranted. Accordingly, the present petition is allowed. The order dated 7.12.2017, passed by this Court, is made absolute.

Petition disposed of.
