Prayer in this application under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is to add offences under Sections 472, 473 IPC in the head-note as well as prayer clause of the main petition.

For the reasons stated in the application, same is allowed and the offences under Sections 472, 473 IPC are also added in the head-note as well as prayer clause of the main petition. Registry is directed to make necessary correction in the head-note as well as prayer clause of the petition.

Prayer in this petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.107 dated 15.09.2018

under Sections 379, 411, 472, 473 IPC, registered at Police Station City Fazilka, District Fazilka.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner is in custody since 15.09.2018 on the allegation of committing theft of his own car. She has referred the document (Annexure P-3), which is a photocopy of the receipt issued by the District Transport Officer, Gurdaspur, in the name of the petitioner and insurance policy of the vehicle in question.

Learned State Counsel has argued that the petitioner is not owner of the car.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Considering the fact that the culpability of the petitioner is required to be established during the course of trial, the offences are triable by the Magistrate and the petitioner is in custody since 15.09.2018, this Court finds that the petitioner deserves to be admitted on bail.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is admitted on regular bail, subject to furnishing of his bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court.
