This is a petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking pre-arrest bail in a case registered against the petitioner under Sections 341, 324, 323, 506, 34 IPC and later on added Section 326 IPC, vide DDR No.24 dated 12.5.2017 at Police Station Kathu Nangal, District Amritsar, vide FIR No.49 dated 7.5.2017.
