The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.132 dated 23.08.2015 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 21, 25, 29 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act (for short 'NDPS') at Police Station Makhu, District Ferozepur.

This is a case of commercial quantity. Although, petitioner is not entitled for the benefit of bail in view of the provisions entail under Section 37 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act yet this court deem it fit to direct the trial court to expedite the trial and the same be concluded within a period of six months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. However, if trial is not concluded within six months then petitioner has the right to prefer another application for bail.
