The petitioner alleges that FIR No.347 dated 07.12.2016 was registered at Police Station Focal Point, Ludhiana, under sections 323/342/506/148/149 IPC against the private respondents on his complaint. The said private respondents are now pressurizing the petitioner through the police officials to compromise the same. A detailed representation dated 13.10.2018 (Annexure P-6) having been submitted but no action has been taken thereupon till date.

Notice of motion to respondents No. 1 to 4 only.

Mr. R.S. Bains, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 4 only. Let five copies of the complete paperbook be supplied to him during the course of the day. Considering the nature of the order being passed, there is no necessity to issue notices to respondents No. 5 to 8.

The petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to objectively consider the representation dated 13.10.2018 (Annexure P-6) and to take appropriate action thereupon in accordance with law, in case it is felt necessary, within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
