This is second petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.995 dated 24.11.2015 under Sections 406, 420, 467, 468, 471, 506, 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Civil Lines, Hisar, District Hisar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has argued that in the aforesaid FIR, matter has been compromised between the parties, for which a quashing petition bearing CRM-M-42438-2017 titled as “Sushila and others Versus State of Haryana and another” has also been filed which is pending for 04.12.2018 before this Court. He further states that the matter has been compromised between the parties and as against total agreed amount of ₹4 lac, petitioner has already paid an amount of ₹2 lac to the complainant. Petitioner is in custody since 24.08.2016.

Learned State Counsel on instructions from ASI Ramphal does

not dispute the aforesaid fact and states that the complainant has submitted

an affidavit that the matter has been compromised.

In view of the fact that when the matter has been compromised between the parties and on the basis of compromise, the quashing petition is pending before this Court and the fact that the petitioner is in custody since 24.08.2016, I deem it appropriate to admit him on regular bail.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is admitted on regular bail, subject to furnishing of his bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court.
