Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.27 dated 10.05.2016 under Section 420 IPC registered at Police Station Joga, District Mansa.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner was declared as proclaimed offender in the case about a year back, but now the matter has been compromised with the complainant/aggrieved persons and the petitioner is ready to surrender before the trial Court.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Surinder Pal Singh Tinna, Additional Advocate General, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent No.1-State.

At this stage, Mr. Davinder Kumar, Advocate has put in appearance and filed power of attorney on behalf of respondents No.2 to 23, which is taken on record.

Learned counsel for respondents No.2 to 23 admits the factum of compromise between the parties and states that the complainant/aggrieved persons have been paid back their money.

Heard.

Though the earlier petition filed by the petitioner seeking anticipatory bail in the present case was dismissed by this Court vide order dated 21.06.2016 passed in **CRM-M-20819 of 2016**, but considering the fact that the petitioner is ready to surrender before the trial Court, the present petition is disposed of with a direction that in case the petitioner surrenders before the trial Court within a week from today, he shall be admitted on bail on his furnishing adequate bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned trial Court, however, subject to payment of costs of Rs.20,000/- by the petitioner to the Poor Patients' Welfare Fund of the Postgraduate Institute of Medical Education and Research (PGIMER), Chandigarh.
