AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J (ORAL)

Counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Sukhwinder Singh, Police Station Moonak, states that the petitioner has joined the investigation and has got recovered the weapon of offence and is no more required for the investigation purposes as of now.

Counsel for the complainant states that there has been a subsequent incident also in which the complainant and his wife have been again attacked by the petitioners and his wife. The wife of the complainant alongwith the complainant is present, who states that the incident is of November 2017.

Keeping in view the fact that the order granting interim bail to the petitioner and directing him to join investigation is of December 2017 and that no further FIR yet has been registered, the contention of the counsel for the complainant at this stage cannot be gone into, especially when the petitioner has joined investigation and is no more required.

In the light of the above, the present petition is allowed.

The order dated 07.12.2017 is made absolute.

Petitioner shall, however, continue joining investigation as and when required.
