The petitioner has impugned the notification dated 25.3.2005 whereby it has been provided that 40% in non PCMS quota, 50% seats shall be filled up from the candidates who have passed their BDS course from the institutes from where they want to seek admission to Post Graduate courses.

The issue of institutional preference has not only been settled by the Hon'ble Supreme Court but also in various pronouncements of this Court as well. Therefore, we are of the opinion that the instant petition deserves to be dismissed. That apart with the passage of time, issue raised in the instant petition has rather been rendered illusory.
