Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been in established possession for many years. There is also a decree of injunction in his favour. Yet, the private respondents are threatening to harvest the standing crop illegally on account of a long standing dispute. A representation dated 15.10.2018 (Annexure P8) has been submitted, but no action has been taken thereupon, till date.

Notice of motion.

Mr. K.S Sidhu, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 3. Let four copies of the petition be supplied to him during the course of the day.

In view of the nature of the order being passed, there is no necessity to call upon respondent Nos.4 and 5, at this stage.

The petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.2 to objectively consider the representation (Annexure P8) and to take appropriate action, in accordance with law, in case it is found necessary,

within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of

this order. It will be ensured that no law and order situation is created at the spot and the life and liberty of the petitioner is secured.
