AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)

Counsel for the petitioners has produced on record a downloaded copy from the website of the order dated 12.02.2018, which shows that the petitioners have appeared before the trial Court and they have been admitted to interim bail. He further states that the petitioners shall continue to appear before the trial Court without fail as and when the date is fixed.

Counsel for the complainant, on the other hand, opposes the prayer of the petitioners and contends that in view of the nature of offence, which has been committed by the petitioners, interim order dated 08.12.2017 passed in favour of the petitioners should not be confirmed. He

vehemently asserts that the petitioners are not entitled to the said benefit.

Having considered the submissions made by counsel for the parties and keeping in view the fact that the petitioners have been summoned in a complaint case, and they, on direction issued by this Court, have appeared before the trial Court and have been admitted to bail, the order dated 08.12.2017 stands confirmed.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
