Petitioner-Prince Pal has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.747 dated 01.08.2018, registered at Police Station Sadar Hisar, District Hisar (Haryana), under Sections 398 and 401 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Sections 25 of the Arms Act, 1959.

Notice of motion has been issued. Learned State counsel appeared and contested the instant petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

The FIR in the present case has been registered on the basis of a secret information that three young boys carrying weapons, in Baleno car which was in accidental condition and without number plate, under the over bridge were trying to loot passers-by. A raid was conducted. The present petitioner was apprehended from the spot and a country made pistol had been recovered from him.

The petitioner has been in custody since 01.08.2018. He is not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as he is in judicial custody. The trial of the case may take long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of ₹50,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
