The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No. 93 dated 18.05.2017, registered under Sections 306/120-B IPC, Police Station City Faridkot, District Faridkot.

Counsel for the petitioner urges that the petitioner is in custody since 18.05.2018. Counsel says that challan has been presented and 11 witnesses have been examined, 9 witnesses have been given up and only two PWs remain. Counsel says that the death had occurred in the matrimonial home after 9 years of the marriage and the postmortem report does not refer to any signs of beating.

Charge has been framed under Section 306 IPC. The trial is taking time. Without commenting upon the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail on execution of adequate personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
