Custody certificate filed in Court today and same is taken on record.

Heard.

It is alleged that four young persons with muffled faces entered Punjab National Bank Village Narot Mehra Branch. One of them was carrying pistol and another was carrying datar. They looted Rs. 93,240/- in Indian Currency and then took complainant to strong room, from where coins of Rs. 10/- and 5/-, contained in a plastic bag, worth Rs. 59,174/- were looted. While leaving the bank, they took away mobile phone, driving licence and identity card of complainant and mobile phone of Agriculture Manager alongwith cash from the staff. During the course of investigation, it came out that present petitioner was standing guard outside bank and actively participated in crime. Petitioner was arrested on 11.7.2018 and is in custody since then.

In this case, challan has already been presented in Court on 26.8.2018. Complainant and other bank staff members are yet to be examined.

Considering the nature of crime, it is not deemed appropriate to grant regular bail to petitioner.

Dismissed.
