Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for quashing of F.I.R. No.209 dated 20.07.2013 under Sections 447, 448, 452, 323/34 IPC, registered at Police Station Civil Lines, Amritsar, District Amritsar City (Annexure P-1) and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise dated 14.09.2017 (Annexure P-2).

This Court vide order dated 08.12.2017 had directed the parties to appear before the learned trial Court/Illaq Magistrate to get their statements recorded and the learned Magistrate was directed to send its report qua the genuineness of the compromise.

Pursuant to the aforesaid order, parties have appeared before learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Amritsar and got their statements

submitted report dated 21.02.2018 to the effect that the parties have willfully settled their differences and reached at bona fide compromise without any pressure and the same seems to be genuine.

At this stage, learned State counsel, on instructions from HC Hardev Singh, states that in this case untraced report was prepared on 07.11.2014 and the same was submitted to the court of Chief Judicial Magistrate, which was accepted on 06.07.2015. Accordingly, FIR in question has already been cancelled.

In view of above, present petition is rendered infructuous and disposed of as such.
