The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for directing respondents No. 2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondents No. 4 to 10 in view of the allegation made in the representation dated 23.10.2017 (Annexure P-10).

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Bhupinder Kumar has stated that the above representation was inquired into by the police and no substance was found in the allegations made therein.

Faced with the situation, learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the instant petition at this stage to avail the remedies permissible under law.

Dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty aforesaid.
