The petitioner has filed this petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in FIR No.0055 dated 30.05.2018 under Sections 380 IPC and Sections 457, 411, 120-IPC added later on, registered at Police Station Bareta, District Mansa.

Heard.

The petitioner Gurwinder Singh was arrested on 05.06.2018 and is in custody since then. In this case, challan has already been presented and the charges were framed on 29.10.2018. The disposal of the trial will take its own time.

It being so, there is no ground for further detention of the

petitioner and accordingly, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of Rs.50,000/- with one surety of the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court, subject to the following conditions:-

- (1) Petitioner shall surrender his passport before the trial Court, if any, and shall not leave the country without prior intimation to the Court;
- (2) Petitioner shall not directly or indirectly give any inducement or threat or promise to any witness and
- (3) Petitioner shall attend the Court on each and every date of hearing before the trial Court and in case of his absence, trial Court shall be competent to cancel his bail.

Accordingly, the petition stands allowed.
