Prayer in this petition is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (in short 'Cr.P.C.') in case FIR No. 152 dated 17.07.2017 under Sections 506 of IPC and Section 67 of Information Technology Act & 3 of Schedule Caste & Schedule Tribe Act, registered at Police Station Bilaspur, District Yamuna Nagar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is in judicial lock up since 09.10.2017 and the matter has been compromised with the complainant and the petitioner has already filed a petition i.e. CRM-M-11961-2018 in which notice of motion has been issued for 30.07.2018. The factum of compromise is not disputed by the learned State counsel, on instructions from HC Julfkar Ali and assisted by learned counsel for the complainant.

Without commenting anything on merits of the case, considering the fact that the petitioner is in judicial lock up since

09.10.2017 and the matter has been compromised with the complainant, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail subject to his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Illaqa Magistrate.
