Pursuant to the order dated 26.12.2018, an affidavit of Sh. Shivraj Singh Nandgarh, Superintendent District Jail, Sri Muktsar Sahib, has been filed in Court today, annexing therewith a report of a board of 03 doctors of the Civil Hospital, Sri Muktsar Sahib, stating therein that the petitioner is “at clinical stage first HIV and yet not landed to AIDS”. It has been further stated that he is capable to care of himself and is not bed ridden.

Upon query to learned State counsel, she on instructions from ASI Vipin Kumar, submits that though recovery of three vehicles and a .12 bore gun were made from the petitioner as per case of the prosecution, the injuries attributed to him are not on the person of any of the deceased but a simple injury on another person.

She further submits that out of 40 prosecution witnesses, none has been examined so far.

That being so and the fact that the petitioner has already been in custody for more than 01 year now, the petition is allowed. The petitioner shall be admitted to bail upon his furnishing adequate bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
