As per the affidavit filed by Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub-Division, Tarn Taran, in Court by learned State counsel, the petitioners' mother is there to look after his wife who is stated to be 37-38 weeks pregnant, with the expected date of delivery being 11.02.2018.

With a number of other cases registered against the petitioner, (though in all the other cases he is stated to be on bail), the DSP has expressed his apprehension that the petitioner may jump bail if it is granted.

It is therefore directed that on the expected date of delivery, i.e. 11.02.2018, the petitioner be taken in custody to the hospital (or his home if the child is to delivered by a midwife), under custody, and brought back 3 hours after the delivery, if the child is delivered that day. If not, then the petitioner would be at liberty to approach the trial Court for being taken in custody to the hospital/home (as the case may be), after the birth of the child.
