AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J (ORAL)

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that as per order passed by this Court on 11.12.2017, petitioner has joined the investigation, which fact is not disputed by the counsel of the State on instructions, from SI Tilak Raj, Police Station Zirakpur, District SAS Nagar Mohali.

He further states that as of now, the petitioner has supplied the relevant documents and no recovery is to be effected from him nor his custodial interrogation required.

Learned counsel for the complainant on the other hand contends that the petitioner has committed a fraud on the complainant and in fact he is a convict in one case and also accused in a CBI case. A report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. has also been submitted and the petitioner has been arrayed as an accused. He, therefore, prays that the present petition be dismissed.

In view of the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required further, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 11.12.2017 is made absolute.

This shall, however, be subject to the terms and conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2)(i) to (iv).
