The petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in a case registered vide FIR No.242 dated 9.8.2018 under Section 379-B Indian Penal Code registered at Police Station Sultanpur Lodhi, District Kapurthala.

The FIR in the present case was lodged at the instance of Manjit Kaur who has alleged that the petitioner had snatched her purse while he had come on a motorcycle.

The learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that he has falsely been implicated in the present case and that in any case the petitioner has been behind bars since the last about 80 days and the challan is stated to have been presented yesterday only.

On the other hand, the learned State counsel has submitted that in view of serious nature of offence, no case is made out for grant of bail.

Having considered the rival submissions addressed before this Court and the fact that the petitioner has been behind bars since the last

more than 2 months and charges are yet to be framed, no useful purpose would be served by further detaining the petitioner behind bars. Accordingly, petitioner-Sandeep is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate Kapurthala.

The petition stands accepted accordingly.
