This is the second petition filed by petitioner-Gurjit Singh under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.11 dated 06.03.2016 registered under Sections 323, 324, 452, 427, 506 read with Section 34 IPC and Sections 326 and 325 IPC added later on, at Police Station Verowal, District Tarn Taran.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the earlier petition filed by the petitioner i.e. Criminal Misc. No. M-20225 of 2016 was dismissed vide order dated 03.07.2016 only on the ground that grievous injury with knife has been attributed to him. Subsequently, cross-version was registered at the instance of petitioner's side and under the changed circumstances, the present petition has been filed. The petitioner is claiming parity with accused in cross-version to whom grievous injury has been attributed.

Admittedly, earlier petition filed by the petitioner i.e. Criminal Misc. No. M-20225 of 2016 was dismissed vide order dated 03.07.2016 only on the ground that grievous injury with knife has been attributed to the

petitioner. Meaning thereby, the petition was dismissed on merits keeping in view the role attributed to the petitioner. Subsequently, cross-version has been registered at the instance of petitioner's side, which is not a changed circumstance to file the second petition.

No ground is made out to release the petitioner on anticipatory bail keeping in view the role attributed to him and also the fact that second petition is not maintainable.

Dismissed.
