The petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.53 dated 21.05.2014, registered under Sections 15, 18, 21, 22 of the Narcotic Drugs & Psychotropic Substances Act, at Police Station Bilga, District Jalandhar.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Avtar Lal, has stated that the petitioner has already surrendered before the learned trial court and has been granted the interim bail.

In these circumstances, without going into the merits of the case, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in the present case.

Ordered accordingly.

Resultantly, the interim order dated 12.12.2017 is made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands allowed.
