The petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of pre-arrest bail in case FIR No.330 dated 02.11.2017, registered under Section 15 of the Narcotic Drugs & Psychotropic Substances Act, at Police Station Talwandi Sabo, District Bathinda.

It is contended that the recovery has already been effected from the co-accused. It is further contended that the name of the petitioner was disclosed by the co-accused.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from Head Constable Randhir Singh, has stated that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is no more required for custodial interrogation.

In the circumstances, without going into the merits of the case,

I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of anticipatory bail to

the petitioner in the present case. Ordered accordingly.

Resultantly, the interim order dated 11.12.2017 is made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands allowed.
