Petitioner Sandeep has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.805 dated 10.12.2017, registered at Police Station City Bhiwani, under Sections 406, 420 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code (However in challan Section 120-B of IPC was also added).

Notice of motion has been issued. Learned State counsel appeared and contested the instant petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

From the record, I find that the present petitioner has not been named in the FIR. The allegation against him, as per his own disclosure statement is that he has been involved for getting the false medical examination of the complainant party by preparing the false documents and he has received Rs.80,000/- out of the grabbed money.

The petitioner has been in custody since 14.08.2018. He is not

required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as he is in judicial

custody. The trial of the case will take long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of ₹50,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
