The instant petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking regular bail on behalf of the petitioner in case FIR No.81 dated 2nd October, 2017, registered under Sections 394/397/326/325/324/341/506 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station Sherpur, District Sangrur.

2. The petitioner was arrested on 9th October, 2017.

3. It transpires that after commitment of the case charges have already been framed against the accused. Admittedly the injuries caused to the victims in the occurrence were found to be simple in nature.

4. In the given circumstances at this stage further indefinite detention of the present petitioner namely Paramjeet Singh @ Premi is not justified. He may therefore be released on bail to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court concerned.
