The learned State counsel has submitted list of 10 cases, pertaining to petitioner and same is taken on record. Perusal of list shows that in 8 cases, petitioner was acquitted and in 1 case, he was convicted, whereas in 1 case, he has undergone sentence.

The learned State counsel has opposed the prayer of learned counsel for petitioner for regular bail on the ground that petitioner is a habitual offender and if released on regular bail, he will commit similar offence.

Considering the background of petitioner and also considering the fact that trial is already proceeding and 6 witnesses have been examined, there is no ground to grant regular bail to petitioner.

In view of matter, petition for regular bail is dismissed.
