The petitioners are employed as Canal Patwaris and Assistant Revenue Clerks and are from the general category. They have challenged the promotion of the private respondents, who belong to the Scheduled Caste category, by way of a writ petition. It is alleged that the private respondents in connivance with the police officials are harassing the petitioners and threatening them with false implication in case the writ petition is not withdrawn.

A representation dated 3.10.2018 (Annexure P1) has been submitted, but no action has been taken thereupon, till date.
