The allegation of the petitioner is that he is owner in possession of certain land. The private respondents were threatening him with forcible dis-possession and therefore, an injunction suit was filed. Temporary injunction has been granted in favour of the petitioner, yet, the private respondents are threatening to forcibly dis-possess him. An earlier representation dated 4.10.2018 was submitted and the same was marked to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala, who further marked the same to the S.H.O of Police Station, Passiana, but no protection has been granted to the petitioner. Resultantly, on 17.10.2018, the private respondents alongwith their henchmen harvested part of the crop sown by the petitioner. They are continuing to threaten the petitioner and another representation dated 18.10.2018 (Annexure P7), has been submitted, but no action has been taken till date.

Notice of motion.

Mr. K.S. Sidhu, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 3. Let four copies of the petition be supplied to him during the course of the day.

In view of the nature of the order being passed, there is no necessity to call upon respondent Nos.4 to 30, at this stage.

The petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.2 to objectively consider the representation (Annexure P7) and to take appropriate action, in accordance with law, in case it is felt necessary, within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
