Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in FIR No.270 dated 21.11.2017 under Sections 406, 420, 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Derabassi, District SAS Nagar.

Vide order dated 20.12.2017, the petitioners were directed to deposit an amount of Rs.11 lacs in this Court.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in compliance of the order dated 20.12.2017, the petitioners have deposited the abovesaid amount on 17.01.2018. Thereafter, the matter was referred to Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court and a settlement arrived has been arrived

at between the parties on 23.04.2018. As per this settlement, the parties have agreed to settle their dispute for a total amount of Rs.18 lacs. Counsel for the petitioners further submits that the petitioners shall abide by the terms and conditions of the settlement and they have already handed over four advance cheques out of which, one cheque is of Rs.1.00 lac and three cheques are of Rs.2.00 lacs each, total comes to Rs.7.00 lacs, as mentioned in the settlement.

Learned counsel for the petitioners as well as learned counsel for the complainant state at the bar that the parties shall be bound by the terms and conditions of the settlement dated 23.04.2018 arrived at between them.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed interim bail granted to the petitioners vide order dated 20.12.2017 passed by this Court is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.

Registry is directed to release the amount of Rs.11 lacs in favour of complainant Prem Singh son of Jit Ram, on proper identification by his counsel Mr. D.D. Gupta, Advocate.

Disposed of, accordingly.
