This is a petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking regular bail in a case registered against the petitioner under Sections 419, 420, 465, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B IPC at Police Station Sarabha Nagar, Ludhiana, vide FIR No.212 dated 27.09.2014. Allegation against her is that she impersonated as Jagdish Kaur Kundi before the bank for the purpose of getting Rs.25.00 lacs as loan.

Admittedly, investigation has been completed and challan put up before the competent court. Petitioner is incarcerated since 19.6.2017. Trial of the case may take long time to conclude. Admittedly, trial is magisterial in nature. Thus, no useful purpose will be served by detaining the petitioner in custody any longer. Thus, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on bail to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Ludhiana.
