Instant petition was filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.92 dated 25.08.2017, under Sections 454, 380, 436 IPC and Sections 4 and 5 of Public Property (Prevention of Damage) Act 1985, registered at Police Station Chhajali, District Sangrur.

While issuing notice of motion on 12.12.2017, interim protection was granted to the petitioner subject to him joining investigation.

Thereafter, petition was taken up on 23.01.2018 and State counsel had informed the Court that petitioner has chosen not to join investigation. Accordingly, directions were issued for the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer on 28.01.2018 at 10:00 a.m.

Learned State counsel informs the Court that the

petitioner did not appear before the Investigating Officer on the stipulated date and time.

Counsel for the petitioner does not rebut such factual premise and rather prays for withdrawal of the petition.

Prayer is allowed.

Dismissed as withdrawn.

It is clarified that the interim protection granted in favour of the petitioner vide order dated 12.12.2017 shall cease to operate.
