The instant petition has been preferred under Section 482 Cr.P.C. assailing the order dated 06.04.1999 (Annexure P-4) passed by the Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Kharar and whereby the petitioner has been declared a proclaimed offender in case FIR No.157, dated 30.12.1995, under Section 456/447/448/457/120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Mohali, District Mohali.

This petition came up for hearing on 07.02.2018 and on such date, petitioner was directed to appear before the trial Court and operation of the impugned order had been stayed meanwhile.

It has gone uncontroverted that the petitioner has joined trial proceedings and has already appeared before the trial Court on 21.03.2018.

Under such circumstances, nothing would survive in the

instant petition and the same is accordingly disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
