Present petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal procedure for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 76 dated 17.3.2017 under Sections 420 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Division-E, Amritsar (Annexure P-1).

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Satwinder Singh submits that matter has been compromised between the parties.

It comes out that it is a case of obtaining loan from the Bank in which it was alleged that petitioner claimed to be a partner of M/s Amar Tractors & others and obtained a loan from the Bank. Since the claim of the Bank has been satisfied and the Bank is apparently not interested in pursuing the matter, present petition is allowed and it is directed that in the event of the arrest of the petitioner who is aged about 70 years, she will be released on bail to the satisfaction of the arresting officer/trial Court.

This order will not prejudice to the State to pursue the case against the petitioner for becoming a proclaimed offender.

Petition stands allowed.
