Prayer in this petition is for issuance of a direction to respondent No.2 to investigate and take appropriate action against the police officials for forcibly entering into the house of the petitioner; misbehaving and manhandling with the petitioner and other family members, and forcibly taking away certain articles and documents, as also for registering a false case bearing FIR No. 693 dated 28.12.2017, against the petitioner.

Reply by way of affidavit of Assistant Commissioner of Police, Panchkula filed in the Court today. It is stated in the reply that FIR No. 693 dated 28.12.2017 under Sections 186, 309, 332, 353 and 511 IPC was registered at Police Station Sector 5, Panchkula against the petitioner and her son. It is further stated that after completion of investigation, report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. has been submitted before the Illaqa Magistrate on 27.03.2018.

In the reply, it is also stated that the petitioner and her son are involved in some other FIRs as detailed in Para No.3 of the reply.

In view of the same, this petition is rendered as infructuous. However, the petitioner is relegated to her remedy for approaching the trial Court.
