The petitioners state that land in dispute has been purchased by them vide registered sale deed dated 20.02.2018. Consequently, mutation has been entered in their favour and they are in possession thereof. Yet, the private respondents are trying to interfere in their lawful possession with the help of the local MLA. A representation dated 12.10.2018 (Annexure P1) has been submitted, but no action has been taken thereupon, till date.

Mr. K.S Sidhu, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 5. Let six copies of the petition be supplied to him during the course of the day.

In view of the nature of the order being passed, there is no necessity to call upon respondent Nos.6 to 10, at this stage.

The petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.3 to objectively consider the representation (Annexure P1) and to take appropriate action, in accordance with law, in case it is felt necessary, within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
