SUDIP AHLUWALIA J. (ORAL)

In this petition, the petitioner, who is the accused in F.I.R No.310, dated 08.10.2015, under Sections 406 and 420 of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Pundri, District Kaithal (Annexure P-1), has prayed for quashing of F.I.R. with all subsequent proceedings, on the basis of compromise.

[2]. With the intervention of respectables and elderly people of the society, respondent Nos.2 to 5 have arrived at a settlement with the accused vide Compromise Deed (Annexure P-2), which is duly signed by them. The matter was referred to the Court below for recording of statements of the parties and to report with respect to genuineness of the compromise arrived at between the parties. The Judicial Magistrate First Class, Kaithal, vide report dated 06.02.2018, has apprised this Court that the compromise arrived at between the parties is genuine and without any pressure.

[3]. Respondent Nos.2 to 5 are represented by their Counsel and do not oppose the compromise.

[4]. In view of the report of the Judicial Magistrate First Class, Kaithal, and in view of the decisions of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in **“Gian Singh Vs. State of Punjab and another”, 2012(4) RCR (Criminal) 543** and **“Narinder Singh and Others Vs. State of Punjab and Another”, (2014) 6 SCC 466**, this Court is of the opinion that no useful purpose can be served by keeping with the criminal proceedings pending, since the respondent Nos.2 to 5 have themselves compromised the dispute with the petitioner/accused.

[5]. In the circumstances, the present petition is allowed. F.I.R No.310, dated 08.10.2015, under Sections 406 and 420 of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Pundri, District Kaithal (Annexure P-1), and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom, are hereby quashed qua the present petitioner.
