This petition has been filed for quashing of FIR No.30 dated 25.02.2016, registered at Police Station Gharinda, District Amritsar, under Sections 325, 148 and 149, IPC.

Order dated 13.12.2017 had been passed in this case and parties were directed to get their statements recorded before the trial Court. However, learned Counsel for the petitioners submits that due to mis-communication, the statement of the parties could not be recorded, though compromise has since been effected.

Be that as it may, the offences in this case are compoundable and the same can be compounded with permission of the trial Court under Section 320(2) Cr.P.C.

In view of above, the present petition is disposed of with direction to the parties to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court on 19.02.2018 and move an appropriate application for composition of the offences, which shall be dealt with by the latter in accordance with law.

Disposed of accordingly.
