Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.357 dated 05.10.2018 under Sections 419, 420 IPC, registered at Police Station Sector-36, Chandigarh.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance of the order dated 31.10.2018, petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for any further investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Davinder Singh, has submitted that though the petitioner has joined the investigation, however, he may be directed to rejoin the investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 31.10.2018 is made absolute.

However, it is directed that the petitioner will join the investigation as and when called by the Investigating Officer and shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
