At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that a copy of the compact disc in the hands of the Investigating Officer must be opened and played in the court in his presence.

Compact disc in the sealed envelope opened and played in the court.

Learned State counsel has submitted that this is the petitioner who was counting the ill-gotten money but the petitioner has disputed this fact.

Heard.

Keeping in view the seriousness of the offences and totality of the circumstances, this court is of the view that petitioner is not entitled to grant bail.

Dismissed.
