Pursuant to the interim orders passed in these petitions on 14.12.2017
and 21.12.2017, the petitioners are all stated to have appeared before the trial

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Court and have been admitted to interim bail to the satisfaction of that Court, in terms of the aforesaid orders of this Court.

The petitioners having been summoned on an application filed under Section 319 Cr.P.C., obviously their custodial interrogation is not required and further, keeping in view the nature of the offences alleged in the report submitted under Section 173 Cr.P.C., with the offences punishable under Sections 3 and 4 of the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989, having been deleted by the investigating agency, the interim orders dated 14.12.2017 and 21.12.2017, granting interim bail to the petitioners, are made absolute, on the same terms and conditions.

However, it is made clear that the aforesaid observations of this Court are wholly in the context of this petition filed, seeking bail to the petitioners, with the said observations to be ignored by the trial Court as regards the merits of the case, for or against the petitioners, which would be considered wholly in the light of the evidence led by the parties.

The petitions are disposed of accordingly.
